## SAFETY AND SECURITY

The safety and well-being of our fans, artists, guests, and staff is paramount. Organizers work closely with local officials to ensure the safest possible experience. You'll notice uniformed security throughout the concert grounds. They are there to keep you safe, so don't hesitate to ask them for help if you need immediate assistance.

REMEMBER: You're the eyes and ears of the concert. If you see something suspicious, say something.

## ENTRY PROTOCOLS

For the safety of everyone entering the festival, all fans are required to enter through ticket and ID checkpoints. Please review our [allowed & prohibited items list](#) before heading to the festival.

## COME PREPARED & LOOK OUT FOR EACH OTHER

Here are four easy ways to look out for yourself and those around you:

1. Watch out for your neighbors – if someone around you looks like they need help, check in with them. If someone is getting unruly, alert the nearest staff member. Keep an eye on your belongings.
2. Be considerate – this is a shared space and we want everyone to enjoy themselves. Keep the vibes chill and your hands to yourself.
3. Use the buddy system – the Lillian Goldman Visitors Center is the designated meeting point for lost or separated people. If one of your friends is in trouble, please alert the concert staff – they will assist you, no questions asked.
4. Keep yourself and your belongings safe – be aware of your surroundings and keep an eye on your personal items at all times. If you find something OR lose something, head to the Lillian Goldman Visitors Center for our Lost and Found.

Here are some helpful tips on how to prepare for the concert:

Have Emergency Contact Info on your person and your phone lock screen in case emergency personnel need to know.

Remember to stay hydrated and keep cool by visiting the Hydration Stations for free, cool, filtered water. Bring your water bottle to refill and help Seed Savers Exchange Benefit Concert be a green and sustainable event!

Protect yourself from the sun - take breaks and find shade. Sunscreen lotion, hats, and sunglasses are key.

Bring hearing protection - we get loud.

Bring a list of allergies and medications you take in case of a medical emergency.

Dress for the weather. We're constantly monitoring the weather. Keep an eye on the radar before heading to the festival so you can dress accordingly (rain boots, ponchos, etc.)

#### ANTI-HARASSMENT POLICY

WE HAVE A ZERO-TOLERANCE POLICY FOR HARASSMENT. PLEASE LET OUR STAFF KNOW IF YOU FEEL HARASSED OR THREATENED IN ANY WAY. NO ALWAYS MEANS NO.

We want every fan to feel safe at the concert. We will not tolerate any harassment based on race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, disability, body size, appearance, age, or national origin. If you feel like you're being harassed, are the victim of nonconsensual touching, or otherwise feel unsafe, please report it to the nearest staff member.
